## Reminiscing the Chinese heritage at the Chinatown Mid-Autumn Festival 2018, Singapore

Hand-crafted lanterns, painted with orchids, peonies and hydrangeas and others in vibrant shades of red, pink, yellow and orange will festoon Chinatown. The design of Mid-Autumn Festival Street Light-up 2018 is the 3rd collaboration between the Organising Committee and Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts (NAFA).

Some other key highlights of this year's festival include:

- Singapore Book of Records attempt for the most oriental masks worn at the same time!
- Nightly Stage Shows, with Dragon Dance performance during the weekend
- Lantern Painting Competition
- Festive Street Bazaar, with over 200 street stalls
- Mass Lantern Walk, with pit-stops to learn more about the Chinatown heritage
