Now observe, In 6 Players circular chess. 2, 3, 4, 6 Individuals can play, that accounts for 4 Variants. 2 team of 3 each can play in 2 ways (Together or Alternate), that accounts for 2 more Variants. Three Teams of 2 each can play in 2 ways (Together or Alternate), that accounts for 2 more Variants. 2 teams of 2 players can play in 3 ways (Together = 1 way & Opposite = 2 Ways), that accounts for 3 more Variants. Hence total Chess Variants in 6 Players Circular Chess = 11. Similarly Open Brief>>12 Players Circular Chess >><https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=2mGqsGTOhQQ>

& Apply Same Logic (Individual & Team) to Verify number of Chess Variants for 12 Players Circular Chess are 27. Similarly number of Chess Variants for 60 Players Circular Chess are 62. Therefore total Number of Chess Variants invented are 100 on 3 Circular Chess Boards invented by Hridayeshwar Singh Bhati

Though there are lot of evidences, that, India is Number 1 in World for Number of Chess Variant
