Requirements for PMP certification

Requirements for the PMP certification exam are revised often in accordance to exam standards. However, the basic requirements are as follows:

- A 4-year degree with a minimum of 3 years project management experience including 4500 hours of leading and directing projects

- A secondary degree with a minimum of 5 years project management experience including 7500 hours of leading and directing projects
- 35 contact hours with Professionals—Professional Development Units (PDU's)

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
