The Act also aims to establish a single reference point for all matters relating to food safety and standards, by moving from multi-level, multi-departmental control to a single line of command. To this effect, the Act establishes an independent statutory Authority – the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India with head office in Delhi. Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) and the State Food Safety Authorities shall enforce various provisions of the Act.

After making changes in old food laws and bringing out more stringent regulations and rules with FSSAI has resulted in the increased safety of the food consumers and owners. The law came into strict consideration due to many controversies including the famous Maggi Noodles fiasco
