
David A. Lessman, MD, Internist and Nephrologist with New York Physicians

Furthering his training he completed his Nephrology Fellowship with the Mount Sinai Medical Center. He also completed a year of basic science research resulting in original publications in the fields of transplant immunology and molecular cell biology concerning the pathogenesis of focal segmental glomerulosclerosis.

Nephrology is a specialty of medicine and pediatrics that concerns itself with the kidneys: the study of normal kidney function and kidney disease, the preservation of kidney health, and the treatment of kidney disease, from diet and medication to renal replacement therapy (dialysis and kidney transplantation). Nephrology also studies systemic conditions that affect the kidneys, such as diabetes and autoimmune disease; and systemic diseases that occur as a result of kidney disease, such as renal osteodystrophy and hypertension.
