Some orthopaedists are generalists, while others specialize in certain areas of the body, other specialty focuses include shoulder and elbow, hand, and spine. Orthopaedic surgeons treat broken bones, and replace painful joints, and also treat patients for sports injuries, back pain, ruptured discs and spinal stenosis, bone tumors, carpal tunnel, hand arthritis and hand injuries, club foot, bow legs and hip dysplasia, orthopedic trauma, limb lengthening, Achilles tendon injuries, bunions and foot, and ankle injuries, osteoporosis, and arthritis.
