participated in neuro-oncology clinical trials at the Winship Cancer Institute, Emory University, since 2008 to present.

Dr Voloschin currently practices as a Neuro-Oncologist & Neurologist and Associate Professor, in Hematology & Medical Oncology with Winship Cancer Institute of Emory University.
