


## Jeremy M. Cotliar, MD, Ophthalmology & Glaucoma Specialist with Dr. Cotliar Eye Care & Surgery

The ABO is an independent, nonprofit organization responsible for certifying ophthalmologists (eye physicians and surgeons) in the United States. The organization certifies

ophthalmologists who have completed an accredited ophthalmic residency training program and demonstrated the required level of knowledge, skills, and experience in ophthalmology.

An ophthalmologist is a specialist in Ophthalmology, the branch of medicine and surgery that deals with the diagnosis and treatment of eye disorders. As an ophthalmologist, Dr Cotliar is trained to perform eye exams, diagnose and treat disease, prescribe medications and perform eye surgery. He can also write prescriptions for eyeglasses and contact lenses.

Dr Cotliar joined the team at Eye Care & Surgery back in 2013. Eye Care & Surgery - located in New York City, New York - provide patients with the highest quality of both medical and surgical care, as well as a friendly, helpful, and efficient experience. Moreover, Dr Cotliar joined the voluntary ophthalmology faculty at the New York- Presbyterian Hospital of Columbia University, where he helps train the residents and fellows in anterior segment eye surgery, including cataract surgery, glaucoma surgery, and pterygium surgery. He also has surgical privileges at the New York Eye and Ear Infirmary of Mount Sinai University.

Dr Cotliar is a fellowship trained glaucoma surgeon. He specializes in both manual and laser-assisted cataract surgery, refractive surgery, such as LASIK AND PRK, and in premium IOL technology for cataract surgery (the type of IOL implanted will make a difference in a patient's ability to see after surgery). Furthermore, he is certified in all of the MIGS (Minimally invasive glaucoma surgeries), including iStent, ECP, and trabectome, which are effective surgeries for mild-to-moderate glaucoma.

Dr Cotliar completed his medical school training at Albany Medical College in 2008. He then completed his 3-year ophthalmology residency at the Montefiore Medical Center of the Albert Einstein College of Medicine in 2012, followed by a year of training in glaucoma eye surgery at the prestigious University of California at Irvine.

Dr Cotliar is fluent in Spanish.
