

Cassandra Shepard: Professional Presentations



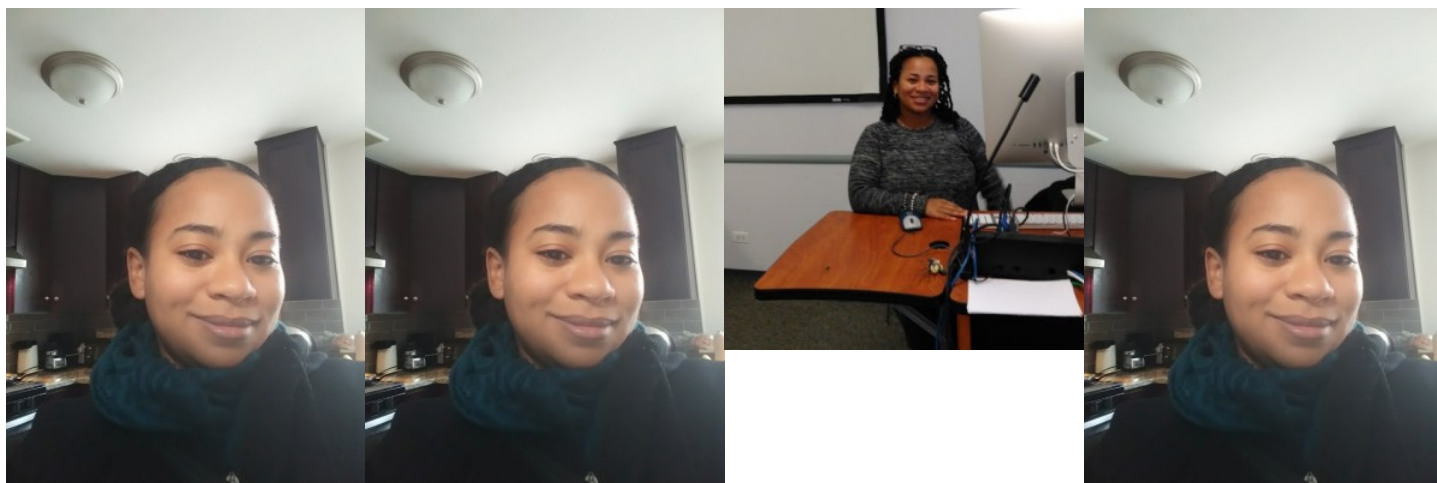
