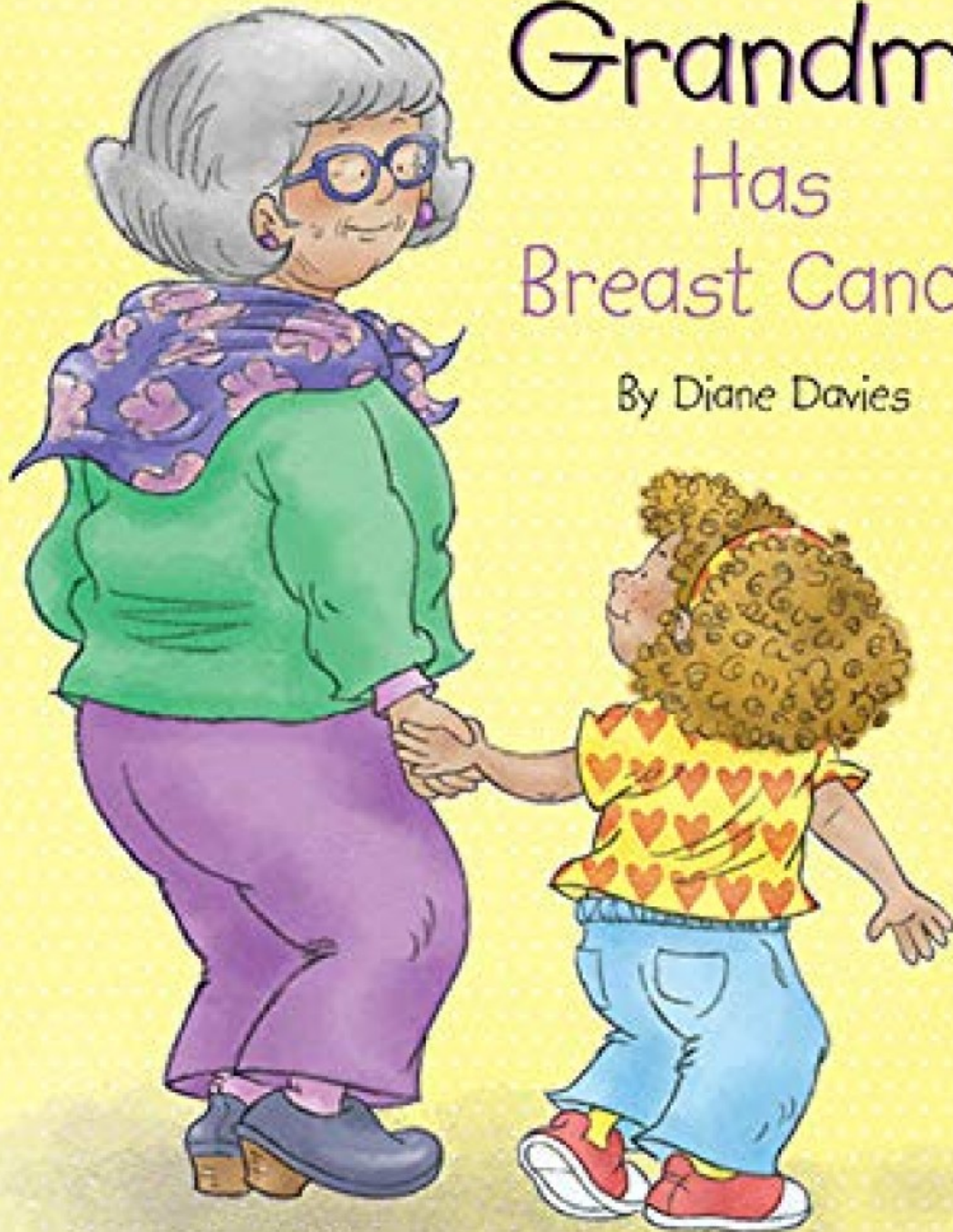


New Children's Book Explains Cancer to Young Readers
