The ticket proceeds will aid the Queen Mothers' School building project in Ejisu (Ghana, West Africa) which is spearheaded by both the reigning Queen Mother of Ejisu, Nana Yaa Asantewaa, II and Bishop Austin Lucas.

As WOMB constituents gather in the same noteworthy locale where she was elected, consecrated, and elevated to the bishopric on Friday, July 15, 2016, the twenty-five picturesque wooded acres at the Princeton Marriott at Forrestal will prove to create an ambiance to promote renewal that fosters healing for women and their families.
