Dr. Wolfe earned his bachelor of science degree in human nutrition from Ohio State University. He then went on to earn his Doctor of Dental Surgery degree from The Ohio State University College of Dentistry in 2002. After graduation, he completed a two-year General Practice Residency at St. Elizabeth Medical Center in Youngstown, Ohio.

Dr. Wolfe is a Master of the Academy of General Dentistry (MAGD). Less than 2% of general dentists in the United States and Canada are MAGDs. To become an AGD Master, a dentist must complete over 1,100 credit hours of continuing education, earn 400 of those 1,100 credits in hands-on courses, as well as pass an exam equal in difficulty to board certification exams. Additionally, Dr. Wolfe is married to his wife, Jessica. They have four children.

Dentistry, also known as Dental and Oral Medicine, is a branch of medicine that consists of the study, diagnosis, prevention, and treatment of diseases, disorders, and conditions of the oral cavity. As a general dentist, Dr. Wolfe diagnoses treats and manages patients' overall oral health care needs, including gum care, root canals, fillings, crowns, veneers, bridges, and preventive education.
