A pain management physician has special training in the evaluation, diagnosis, and treatment of all different types of pain.

Anesthesiology, anaesthesiology, anesthesia or anesthetics is the medical specialty concerned with the total perioperative care of patients before, during, and after surgery. Anesthesiologists specialize in anesthesia care, pain management, and critical care medicine.
