Emergency physicians care for unscheduled and undifferentiated patients of all ages. An emergency physician, like Dr. Welber, is a physician who works at an emergency department to care for ill patients. They specialize in advanced cardiac life support, resuscitation, trauma care, such as fractures and soft tissue injuries, and management of other life-threatening situations.
