During his time at the University of Toledo, he received several awards including the Most Outstanding Second and Third Year Resident awards consecutively, which are awarded by fellow residents. He also received the Excellence in General Pediatrics Award, which is a nomination granted by the university attendings.

In 2014, Dr. Sunallah was awarded by the American Academy of Pediatrics National Conference and Exhibition's Section on Emergency Medicine in San Diego, California, for an Outstanding Pediatric Emergency Medicine Fellow Research paper presentation. While at the University of Alabama at Birmingham, he was also awarded the Pediatric Subspecialty Research Award, given to pediatric fellows for best research of the year.

In addition to being a Fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics, Dr. Sunallah is board-certified in pediatrics by the American Board of Pediatrics (ABP). The ABP is an independent, nonprofit organization that was founded in 1933 and one of the 24 certifying boards of the American Board of Medical Specialties.

Pediatrics is the branch of medicine that involves the medical care of infants, children, and adolescents. As a pediatrician, Dr. Sunallah examines, diagnoses, and treats children of all ages with a wide variety of injuries and illnesses. He understands that children change rapidly and that they must be approached with an appreciation for their stage of physical and mental development.
