Supported by funding from Mars Wrigley Confectionery and implemented by Tanager, the first year of the program brought a team of 30 extension workers to more than 126 villages across the state. These workers trained farmers on better growing practices – focusing on fundamentals such as irrigation frequency and fertilizer application.
