Before long, Dr. Shah became board-certified in ophthalmology by the American Board of Ophthalmology, an independent, non-profit organization responsible for certifying ophthalmologists in the United States of America.

In order to stay up to date in his field, he remains a member of the American Society for Cataract and Refractive Surgery, the Contact Lens Association of Ophthalmology, the Pennsylvania Academy of Ophthalmology, and the Pittsburgh Ophthalmology Society. He is also a Fellow of the American Academy of Ophthalmology.

An important part of Dr. Shah's approach to constantly advancing the scope and efficacy of his care can be found with his dedication to research. He has focused on subjects including molecular epidemiology, the interaction of radio-labeled antibodies to carcinoma, and multiple studies related to glaucoma and dry eye disease. His published work in phacolytic glaucoma and laser through opaque media is widely read online and in respected academic journals. His presentations have been accepted by prestigious organizations, including the Association for Research in Vision and Ophthalmology and the Pittsburgh Ophthalmologic Society.

Ophthalmology is a branch of medicine and surgery, which deals with the diagnosis and treatment of eye disorders. Ophthalmologists are experts in the diseases, functions, and anatomy of the eye. They may provide routine care such as vision testing, as well as prescribe and fit eyeglasses or contact lenses. However, ophthalmologists are also surgeons.
