
## **Tina M. Rendini, MSN, FNP, Family Nurse Practitioner with Bellevue Hospital**

Given the rather broad nature of the "family" patient population focus, FNPs offer a wide range of healthcare services that revolve around the family unit; from health promotion and disease prevention to direct care and counseling across the lifespan.

When asked what she attributes her success to, Tina answered that it is due to her love of the field and her strive to make a difference. Her sister, who is also a nurse, was a great mentor and an inspiration to her, as were her colleagues and mentors.
