Shortly after his government service in that role, he was appointed by the Colombian Ministry of Foreign Affairs as Administrative Consul in the Colombian Consulate in NY, where the benefit of the Colombian community in the Greater New York area and supervised a team of officials and contractors. In addition to an impressive professional career, Felipe has a strong education foundation. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Naval Electronics engineer from Escuela Naval "Almirante Padilla", and an MBA from INALDE Business School.
