Root canal treatment is a treatment sequence for the infected pulp of a tooth that results in the elimination of infection and the protection of the decontaminated tooth from future microbial invasion. This treatment involves the removal of the previous crown and packing material, the cleansing of the root canals, and the re-packing and re-crowning of the tooth. Root canal therapy and retreatments are a better alternative than extraction for most individuals. Root canal therapy is basically done in three steps and it also takes one and three sessions to complete.

Cleaning The Root Canal

During this treatment, the dentist first removes everything that is inside the root canal. And with anesthesia application, the dentist makes a small access hole on the surface of the tooth and removes the diseased and dead pulp tissue with very small files.

Filling the Root Canal

After that, the dentist cleans, shapes, and decontaminates the hollow area, using tiny files and irrigation solutions and then the tooth is filled with a rubber-like material, using an adhesive cement to seals the canals completely.

After this therapy, the tooth is dead and the patient will no longer feel any pain in that tooth because the nerve tissues have been removed and the infection has been eliminated.

Adding a Crown or Filling

The tooth will be now more fragile than it was before. And a tooth with no pulp receives its nourishment from the ligament that attaches the tooth to the bone. It is adequate, but in time, the tooth will become more brittle, so a crown or filling offers protections. After completing the crown or filling, the person can use the tooth as before.

This is the process of root canal therapy, it takes only one appointment, but if there are curved canals, multi canals, or large infections, this could take one or two additional appointments.
