Via the proprietary live footage streaming technology, post-production time can be narrowed down to a fraction of what it has been in the past by merging directing and post-production onto one platform. The collaboration is expected save 60% of labor cost, and generate millions of revenue for the company.

Stephen, a former AI researcher in the NASA funded SETI project, founded Living 3D to craft technological innovations and solutions to drive long-term growth in favourable sectors.
