
Actress Elsi Eng gears up for her second film production

In 2020, Elsi is now gearing up to co-produce and star in the feature film "Ai Lun", working alongside LA-based award-winning director Hector Abaunza. This is a story about triplet sisters and Elsi will face the challenge of portraying 3 identical-looking but different women with their own tragic stories.

"I'm trying to bring most of the production from LA to Vancouver, where I grew up because I want to showcase the beautiful landscape and cityscape (of Vancouver)" Elsi said. As an actress, she finds wearing the hat a producer exhilarating, she said: "I'm finally doing things I have always wanted to do but didn't because I tricked myself into believing that I was too young, too old, too basic, too out there..."
