He has extensive training in forefoot and rearfoot surgery along with a certification in ESWT, ultrasound, skin biopsy, sports injuries, and custom orthotic treatment for correcting foot deformities and discomfort.

Among his professional affiliations, he is a member of the American College of Foot and Ankle Surgeons, the American Podiatric Medical Association, and the Washington State Podiatric Medical Association. What's more, he is board-certified through the American Board of Lower Extremity Surgery and the American Board of Podiatric Surgery.
