She also served several years in the Pre Alumni Association's Community Day Activities, which provided stimulating activities and physicals to the children from the local neighborhood and housing projects in Nashville, as well as organized Career Day Programs for high school students during her graduate school tenure at Meharry Medical College.

She then went on to complete her residency in family medicine at Advocate Illinois Masonic Medical Center in Chicago, Illinois. Her desire to serve an underrepresented population did not stop in Chicago. She participated in a Community Health Program to provide medical care to a population of homeless patients at the Pilsen Homeless Center.

Following the completion of her residency, Dr. Taylor-Moragne came to Jackson, Tennessee to continue her mission of serving an underserved population at the East Jackson Family Medical Center before opening her own private practice.

A Fellow of the American Academy of Family Physicians, the doctor is board-certified in family medicine by the American Board of Family Medicine, which is a non-profit, independent medical association of American physicians who practice in family medicine and its sub-specialties.

Family medicine is a medical specialty devoted to comprehensive health care for people of all ages. The specialist is called a family physician or family doctor. A family physician is often the first person whom a patient sees when seeking healthcare services. They examine and treat patients with a wide range of conditions and refer those with serious ailments to a specialist or appropriate facility.
