
Michael S. Ruddat, MD, an Ophthalmologist with Retina Consultants

Ophthalmology is a branch of medicine and surgery, which deals with the diagnosis and treatment of eye disorders. Ophthalmologists are experts in the diseases, functions, and anatomy of the eye.
