What's more, he is board-certified through the American Board of Otolaryngology – Head and Neck Surgery, whose mission is to serve the public by ensuring that diplomates meet the standards of training, knowledge, and professionalism through initial and continuing certification.

Dedicated to the profession of medicine, Dr. Gibbs has been presented with several awards and honors, including the 4th Annual Special Friend Award by Marshall University Dept of Pediatrics, the Best Resident Research Paper Award by the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center - Parkland Memorial Hospital, as well as Mountcastle Merit Scholar by Vanderbilt University School of Medicine.
