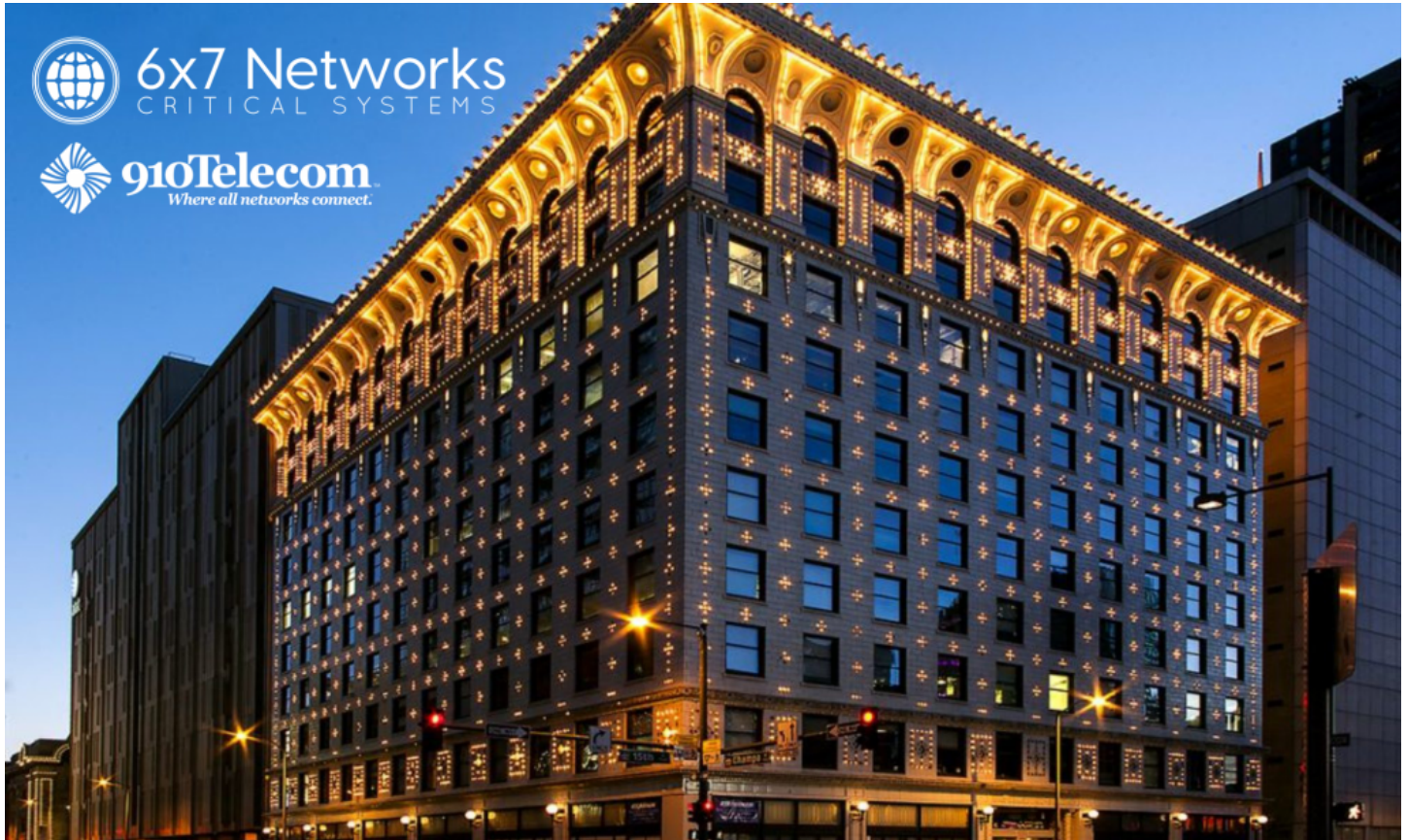

The facility currently contains 8,000 kW of critical IT capacity and services early, middle-market and Fortune 1000 corporations and other global telecommunications carriers such as Verizon (NYSE: VZ) and CenturyLink (NYSE: CTL) and Telia Carrier (TELIA:SS).

This new PoP furthers 6x7's goal of providing businesses and networks in the Denver Area with additional connectivity options, enabling greater bandwidth and reduced latency through connections as fast as 600GE (600 gigabit Ethernet). Additionally, customers of 910 Telecom Center will experience improved fault tolerance, load balancing and congestion management infrastructure capabilities for the delivery of both IPv4 and IPv6 access services, as well as fully encrypted layer2 transport to Amazon AWS, Microsoft Azure, and Google Cloud. They will also have the opportunity to exchange traffic with 6x7's rich global network.

"910 Telecom is strategic to 6x7's expansion, and a key to our goal of being the fastest and most diverse internet carrier in the world. 910 Telecom's positioning near the CenturyLink and AT&T Central Offices, in the classic Denver Gas and Electric Building, is a marriage of utility infrastructure
