Sauter noted, "I filed to run for District 3 Supervisor because I believe we can do better. Better for small business owners who struggle to open their doors in our neighborhoods, better for families who deserve safe parks and streets, and better for the next generation of artists and immigrants who want to chase

their own San Francisco dream."
