He completed his residency in plastic surgery at the Medical College of Georgia Hospital and Clinics, in Augusta, Georgia.

A Fellow of the American College of Surgeons, the doctor is board-certified in plastic surgery by the American Board of Plastic Surgery, whose mission is to promote safe, ethical, efficacious plastic surgery to the public by maintaining high standards for the education, examination, certification, and continuous certification of plastic surgeons as specialists and subspecialists. He is also a member of the American Society of Plastic Surgeons and the John Staige Davis Society of the Plastic Surgeons of Maryland.

In the past, Dr. Garazo was the Chief of Plastic Surgery at Washington County Hospital. He now serves on the consulting staff for both Chambersburg Hospital and Waynesboro Hospital. He also fills the role of Medical Advisor for Cumberland Valley Breast Cancer Awareness.

Plastic surgery is a surgical specialty involving the restoration, reconstruction, or alteration of the human body. It can be divided into two main categories - reconstructive surgery and cosmetic surgery. A plastic surgeon's primary responsibility is performing surgical and non-surgical procedures, and they use a variety of reparative and reconstructive techniques to get the job done.

With a strong commitment to excellence in plastic surgery, Dr. Garazo has been listed in Vogue, Glamour, Allure, and Self magazines as one of the "Outstanding Plastic Surgeons in Maryland" and has been honored as one of "America's Top Plastic Surgeons" for eight consecutive years.
