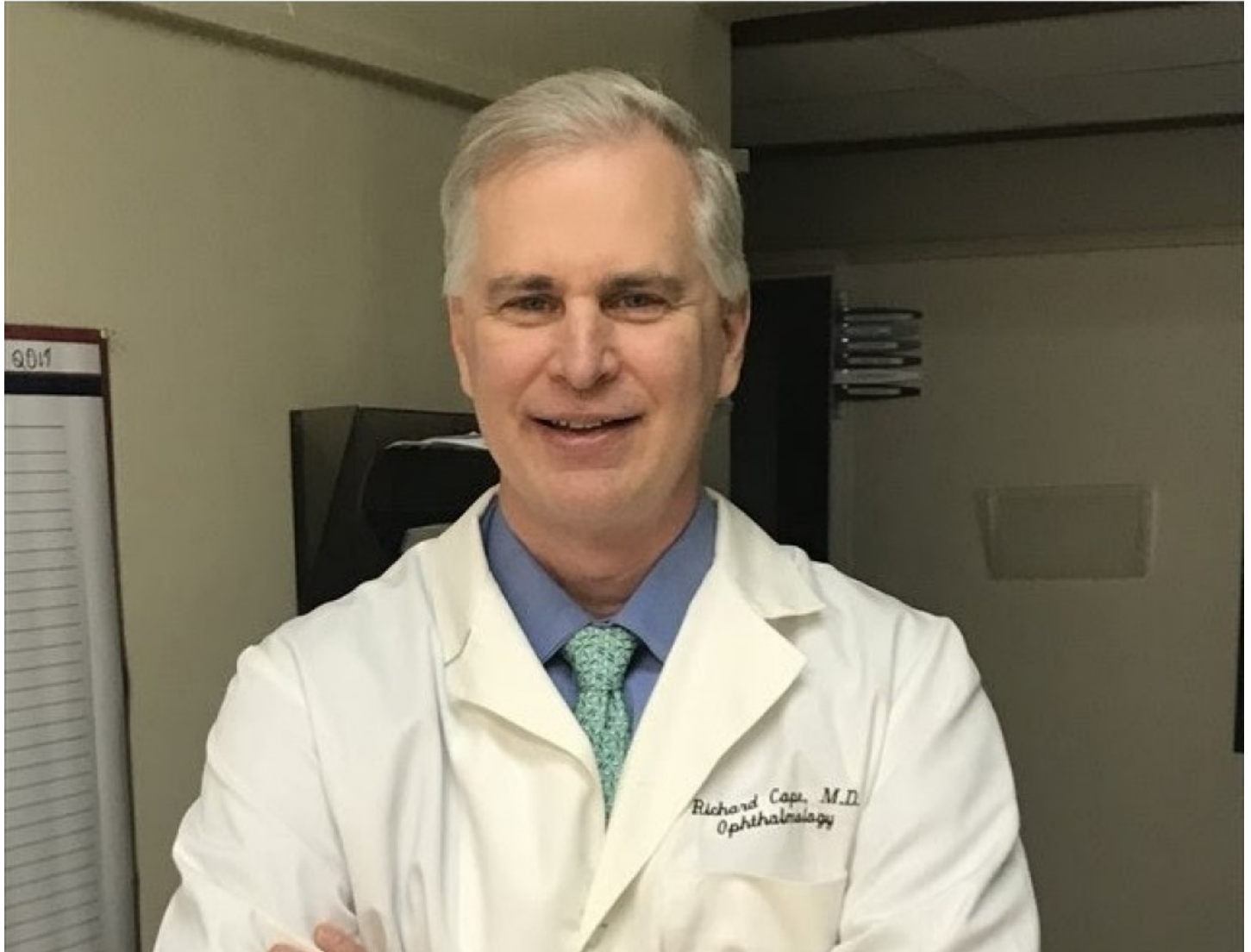


Richard Cape, MD, an Ophthalmologist with Cape Regional Eye Center, PLLC & Cape Surgery Center, LLC

His work has been published in the prestigious ophthalmology textbook, Principles and Practices of Ophthalmic Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery. What's more, he was a co-author of the publication "Surgical Intervention in Conjunction with Medical Treatment of Cicatricial Pemphigoid" in Vol. II of Principles and Practice of Ophthalmic Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery by Stephen Bosniak, MD.
