
Richard L. Turner, DO, FACOOG, an Obstetrician-Gynecologist with Women's Specialists of Bucks County

An obstetrician-gynecologist, or OB-GYN, is a healthcare professional who specializes in female reproductive health.

Recognized for his clinical expertise, Dr. Turner has been the recipient of several awards and honors throughout his line of work, including Compassionate Doctor Recognition from 2013 to 2015 and Patients' Choice Award from 2011 to 2015.
