Early in her medical career, she developed an affinity for children who displayed special needs. She received her Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree from the College of New Rochelle and her medical degree from the Albert Einstein College of Medicine.

After completing her residency in pediatrics at the Bronx Municipal Hospital Center, where she also served as chief resident, Dr. McCarton received two prestigious post-doctoral research fellowships from the Department of Psychiatry at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine and the Rose F. Kennedy Center for Research in Mental Retardation and Human Development at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine.

Since finishing her formal training in 1977, she has served as Director of the Clinical Research Unit at the Rose F. Kennedy Center and Director of the L.I.F.E. (Low Birth Weight Infant Follow-Up and Evaluation) Program. Her research experience includes national studies of developmental complications in infants with low birth weight, infant health and development, and the prevention of mental retardation.

Having taught pediatrics for over 25 years, Dr. McCarton is currently a Clinical Professor of Pediatrics at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine. She is also a member of many professional societies, including the American Academy of Pediatrics, the Society for Behavioral Pediatrics, the Society for Research in Child Development, the International Neuropsychology Society, and the American Academy for Cerebral Palsy and Developmental Medicine.

The doctor is board-certified in pediatrics by the American Board of Pediatrics (ABP), which is one of the 24 certifying boards of the American Board of Medical Specialties. Founded in 1933, the ABP is an independent, nonprofit organization whose certificate is recognized throughout the world as a credential signifying a high level of physician competence. Certification by the ABP has one objective, to promote excellence in medical care for children and adolescents.

Pediatrics is the branch of medicine that involves the medical care of infants, children, and adolescents. The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends people be under pediatric care up to the age of 21. As a pediatrician, Dr. McCarton provides medical care to people ranging in age from newborns to young adults. She is trained to examine, diagnose, and treat children with a wide variety of injuries and illnesses through all of their developmental stages, as they grow and mature.

Inducted into the Top Doctors of the New York Metro Area, Dr. McCarton has received numerous honors throughout her extensive career, including grants from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, the Pew Charitable Trusts, and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. She has also published over 50 book chapters and peer-reviewed articles in journals such as the Journal of the American Medical Association (JAMA), Child Development, the Journal of Pediatrics, and Developmental Medicine and Child Neurology.

Upon reflecting on a rewarding career, she attributes her success to her belief in the field and hard work. She wanted to be a doctor from a very young age. She remembers her own doctor making house calls and was fascinated by his visits. It made a lasting impression on her.
