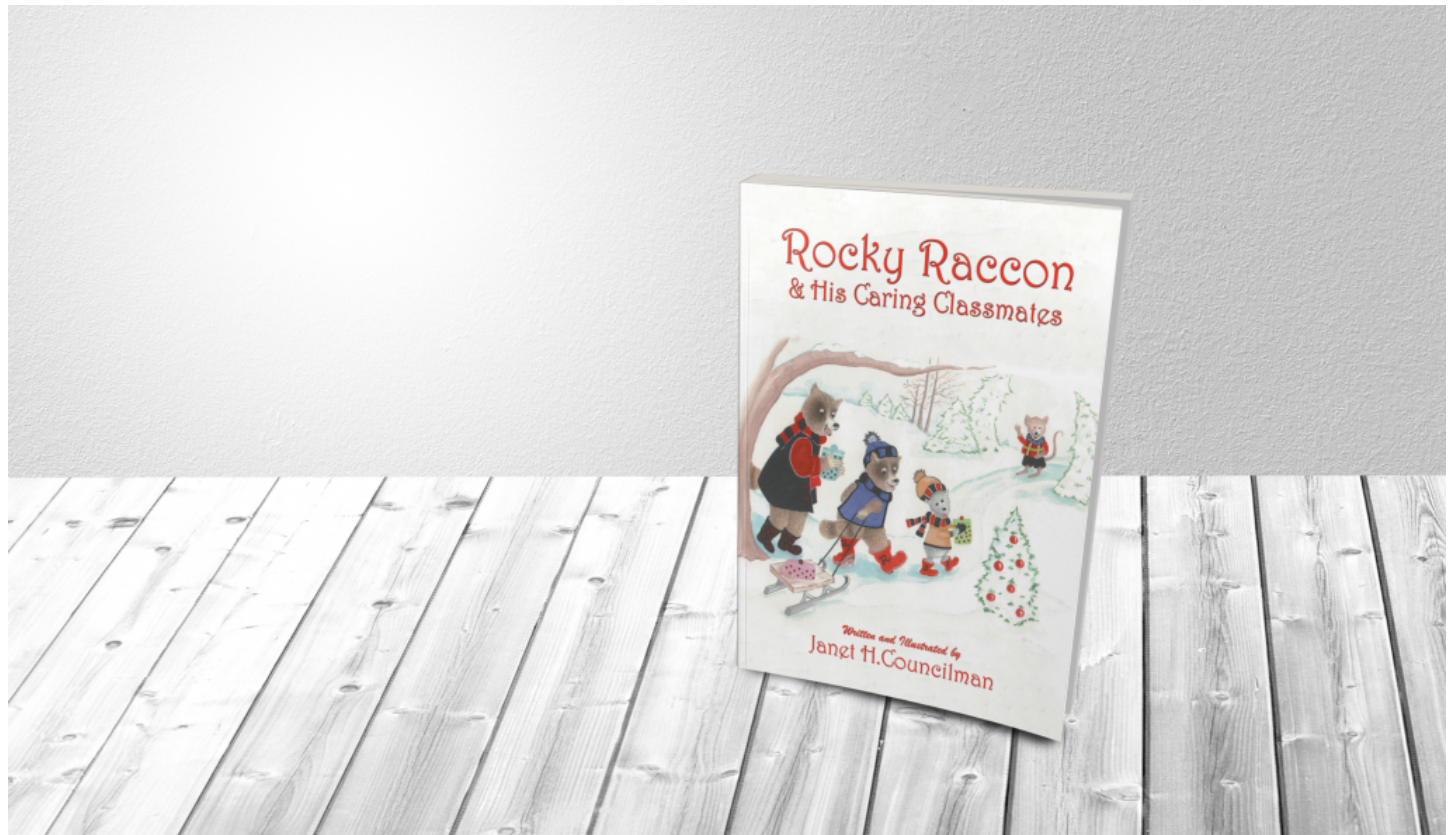


How to Be Kind in Simple Ways: An Effective Tip
