Holding a Registered Physician in Vascular Interpretation (RPVI) Certification, he is also board-certified in nuclear cardiology, echocardiology, and computed tomography angiography.

An interventional cardiologist is a cardiologist with one to two years of additional education and training in diagnosing and treating cardiovascular disease, as well as congenital and structural heart conditions through catheter-based procedures, such as angioplasty and stenting.
