
Davide Sakures MASCHINE - house music against the corona madness

Davide Sakures new release cannot heal infections but it can help to overcome bad mood while being in quarantine or staying at home due to contact restrictions.



Berlin, Apr 22, 2020 (Issuewire.com) - Dancing does not prevent an infection, but it definitely helps against tribulation and a bad mood in times of coronavirus quarantine. The same applies to creativity. Davide Sakure's new house track MASCHINE was created during the quarantine.

The German with the somewhat unusual name has become one of the most hyped names and insider tips in Japan and South Korea when it comes to music production and remixes.

Davide Sakure, who mostly lives in Japan, is currently in Berlin under Corona quarantine and works in his project studio on a number of remixes for clients or to write and record new music. Making music is definitely one of the best methods against getting depressed or mad due to the corona virus-related contact restrictions.

Sakure is a musician through and through. Perhaps that's why genres seem to be relatively marginal for him. His own songs are electronic and danceable. But he also remixes metal tracks and rock songs from his customers or participates in customer productions as a keyboardist.

After YURAI, MASCHINE is Davide Sakure's second pure house music track. The base is a simple musical theme, elaborated in several variations and provided with a dash of EDM. The straightforwardness of the track is pleasantly noticeable. MASCHINE is by no means boring. With a furtive look at the predecessor YURAI, one could say that Davide Sakure is bringing a certainly lost diversity back into the commercial part of electronic music.

Davide Sakure's distinguishing feature is the widespread use of synthesizers and, in some song parts, self-recorded atmos. Sakure's music is pretty close to the music of progressive musicians, but with a shot of EDM.

MASCHINE by Davide Sakure will be released worldwide as a digital single on May 1, 2020. The official music video is now available on Youtube, Vimeo and Facebook.
