He is a member of the Nevada Osteopathic Medical Association, the American Medical Association, the American Osteopathic Association, Sigma Sigma Phi, the Chi Chapter Honor Society, the American Osteopathic College of Ophthalmology, and the American Academy of Ophthalmology.

The doctor is board-certified in ophthalmology by the American Board of Ophthalmology, whose mission is to serve the public by improving the quality of ophthalmic practice through a process of certification and Maintenance of Certification that fosters excellence and encourages continual learning. He is also a Fellow of the Osteopathic College of Ophthalmology (FOCOO), as well as remains affiliated with Stone Creek Surgery Center.

They may provide routine care such as vision testing, as well as prescribe and fit eyeglasses or contact lenses. However, ophthalmologists are also surgeons. They repair traumatic injuries to the eye and perform cataract, glaucoma, and corneal surgery.
