Thereafter, he spent his first two years managing critically ill patients in the general surgery program in addition to learning surgical techniques from the vascular, trauma, plastics, cardiothoracic, and transplant surgical services. He also finished four years of urology training, where he cared for adult and pediatric patients.

A Fellow of the American College of Surgeons (FACS), the doctor is a member of the American Urological Association, the American Association of Clinical Urologists, the American Medical Association, the Endourological Society, and the Spokane County Medical Society.

In addition, he is board-certified in urology by the American Board of Urology, whose mission is to act for the benefit of the public by establishing and maintaining standards of certification for urologists, as well as to work with certified urologists to achieve lifelong learning to ensure the delivery of high quality, safe, and ethical urologic care.

Taking a multidisciplinary approach to urologic medicine, Dr. Deters believes that effective urologic care begins with patient education and an open discussion about the condition and the many available treatment options.
