

Veterinarian DR. Erica Barron's New Book is a Reawakening about the Importance of Acupuncture

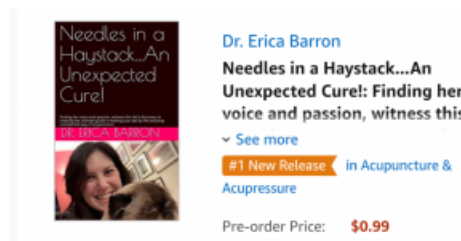
