Physical medicine and rehabilitation, also known as physiatry, is a branch of medicine that aims to enhance and restore functional ability and quality of life to those with physical impairments or disabilities. Physiatrists treat a wide variety of medical conditions affecting the brain, spinal cord, nerves, bones, joints, ligaments, muscles, and tendons. Not only does Dr. Pang perform electrodiagnostic studies to help diagnose patients with nerve and/or muscle disorders, he is also well-versed in ultrasound and regenerative medicine such as prolotherapy and platelet-rich plasma (PRP) injection.

Pain management is a branch of medicine employing an interdisciplinary approach for easing the suffering and improving the quality of life of those living with chronic pain. A pain management specialist is a doctor who specializes in pain medicine, focusing on the evaluation, treatment, and prevention of pain. Dr. Pang utilizes various treatment modalities including oral medications, joint injections, spine injections (epidurals, facet-related injections, rhizotomy), and neuromodulation (spinal cord stimulator, a peripheral nerve stimulator, etc) to not only ease the pain but also help promote a positive transformation in his patients' lives.
