
## Gregory Marcolin, PT, DPT, a Doctor of Physical Therapy with OceanView Rehabilitation

After earning his bachelor's degree in Health & Nutrition Sciences from CUNY Brooklyn College in 2007, Dr. Marcolin went on to obtain his Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) degree from SUNY Downstate Health Sciences University in 2012. From 2012 until 2017, he served as the Clinical Director of Physical Therapy at Evolve Physical Therapy Fit for Life before joining the OceanView team.

Physical medicine and rehabilitation, also known as physiatry and physiatrics, is a branch of medicine that aims to enhance and restore functional ability and quality of life to those with physical impairments or disabilities. Physiatrists treat a wide variety of medical conditions affecting the brain, spinal cord, nerves, bones, joints, ligaments, muscles, and tendons.
