A prominent professional, Dr. Bazzan is a nationally-renowned expert in bioidentical hormone replacement for treating the symptoms of natural midlife decline in hormone production, nutritional oral and intravenous therapies designed to restore general health or support treatment for cancer and other diseases. A particular focus is dedicated to teaching patients the fundamental rules of fostering health. His practice of meditation spurred an interest in Oriental Medicine and philosophy, thus leading him to an understanding of health and related issues broader than the conventional Western medical model.

Originally from Verona, Italy, the doctor's acclaimed career in medicine began after he earned his medical degree from the University of Padua School of Medicine in Padua, Italy. Upon relocating to the United States, he completed his internship at Frankford Hospital, residency at Presbyterian-University of Pennsylvania Medical Center, followed by a fellowship in geriatrics at Albert Einstein Medical Center. Furthermore, he is board-certified through the American Board of Integrative Holistic Medicine, whose vision is to establish and maintain the highest standards of medical care, ignite and sustain the joy and passion of physicians in their work, establish the role of unconditional love as the basis of healing and support, and to recognize the importance of the health of the planet as integral to human health.
