Nearly four out of five Americans believe that the nation is on the wrong political path, and about 57% of Americans believe that it is high time for a major third political party.

A major third political party is indispensable in stirring up years of governmental malpractice and manipulation of policies and to bring about the winds of change that will lead the nation to political and personal deliverance.
