- **August 6th-9th, 2020** - Officially takes place the first Thursday-Sunday every August.
- **34th Consecutive Year** - The 127 Yard Sale began in 1987 making 2020 the 34th year it's taken place. It has never been canceled.
- **690 Mile Route** - The route stretches across 6 states (Michigan, Ohio, Kentucky, Tennessee, Georgia, and Alabama) from Gadsden, AL in the south to Addison, MI in the north.

Staying Safe While Shopping *The World's Longest Yard Sale*

The safety and health of all participants of the 127 Yard Sale are of paramount importance. When deciding whether this event could go on safely many factors were carefully considered. It was decided that with the help of all participants working together to follow CDC as well as state and local guidelines and requirements this event could take place and still be a fun and relaxing event.

As a mostly outdoor event, there is more than enough space to allow for social distancing at the 127 Yard Sale. All participants are encouraged to bring a mask as well as hand sanitizer.

What makes the 127 Yard Sale an important event?

In addition to providing essential outdoor recreation, fun, and enjoyment, this event takes place in mostly rural areas in the states where the route passes through. Many of the vendors who participate earn a significant portion of their yearly income at this event. It also provides a significant positive economic impact on many hotels, motels, RV parks & campgrounds, restaurants, and other retail businesses. This year more than ever these businesses desperately need the revenue generated during the 127 Yard Sale.

How will this year's 127 Yard Sale be different?

It's recommended that vendors and property owners display signage encouraging social distancing as well as CDC recommended hygiene and sanitizing practices. In addition, most states and some counties along the route are requiring the use of face masks when social distancing is not possible. More information can be found on 127YardSale.com.

Rain/Weather

The 127 Yard Sale always goes on rain or shine. Rain is very common at this time of the year especially at the southern portions of the route, like Tennessee, Georgia, and Alabama. However, rainstorms typically are scattered and brief so if vendors are forced to close they will reopen as soon as possible. Also, everyone should keep in mind that forecasts often change drastically in just a day or two.

"Every year people ask how rain will affect the 127 Yard Sale? I tell them, it won't! It's always going to rain somewhere on the expansive 690-mile route, but the vendors are prepared and ready to handle it. Worst case scenario you take a break and get a bite to eat and then get right back to shopping."

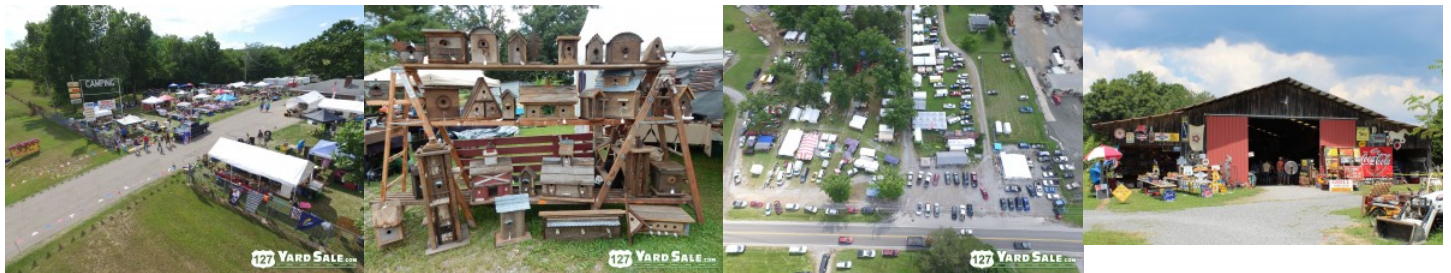
