Wanting to further his training, he went on to complete his residency in orthopedic surgery and his fellowship in hand surgery at Nassau University Medical Center in 1973 and 1974, respectively.

With an unwavering commitment to his speciality, he is board-certified in orthopedic surgery by the American Board of Orthopedic Surgery (ABOS). The ABOS is an organization with the goal of establishing educational and professional standards for orthopedic residents and surgeons as well as evaluating the qualifications and competence of orthopedic surgeons.

To date, Dr. Montero remains a member of numerous organizations and societies, including the American College of Surgeons (Fellow), the American Academy of Orthopedic Surgeons (Fellow), the International College of Surgeons (Fellow), the American Medical Society, the Nassau County Medical Society, the New York State Medical Society, the New York State Society of Orthopedic Surgeons, the Italian Society for Surgery of Hand, the New York Society for Surgery of Hand, the American Society of Surgery for Hand, the American Association for Surgery of Hand, and the Nassau Academy of Medicine. He is also the recipient of the Physician's Recognition Award by the American Medical Association (1972).
