A Fellow of the American College of Cardiology (FACC), the doctor is board-certified in cardiovascular disease and interventional cardiology by the American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM). The ABIM is a physician-led, non-profit, independent evaluation organization driven by doctors who want to achieve higher standards for better care in a rapidly changing world.

Recognized as a prime leader in his field, Dr. Lapan is one of the Founders of a family-funded foundation called the Lapan Sunshine Foundation, Inc. The mission of the Foundation is to continue the legacy of Patricia Lapan by supporting the Lapan College Club (LCC) directly and indirectly through partner programs, and broadly investing in the lives of youth through their education.

Since its inception, Dr. Lapan has served on the Board of the Foundation and oversees the management of the Foundation's endowment and yearly budget. He takes an active leadership role in the development of the Foundation's programs and mission. He visits the LCC on a weekly basis to interact with the students and to keep his finger on the pulse of the programs. In addition to LCC, the family supports various world charities, helps outstanding students with graduate and postgraduate scholarships, and supports NCAA athletic programs.

The field includes medical diagnosis and treatment of congenital heart defects, coronary artery disease, heart failure, valvular heart disease, and electrophysiology. Cardiologists are doctors who diagnose, assess, and treat patients with diseases and defects of the heart and blood vessels (the cardiovascular system).
