De Grasse is a Canadian sprinter with one silver Olympic medal in the 200m, two bronze medals in the 100 m and 4x100m relay, as well as four medals from the World Championships. Bartoletta is an American track and field athlete who specializes in the long jump and short sprints. Her accolades include three gold Olympic medals in the long jump and 4x100m relay, as well as several gold medals from both the World and World Indoor Championships. Schippers is a Dutch track and field athlete who competes primarily in the sprints, and her achievements include a silver Olympic medal in the 200m and several medals at the World Championships in both the 100m and 200m. Ali is an American track and field athlete who specializes in the 100 meter hurdles. She is 2016 Olympic Silver Medalist and the 2019 Gold medalist for the 100m hurdles.
