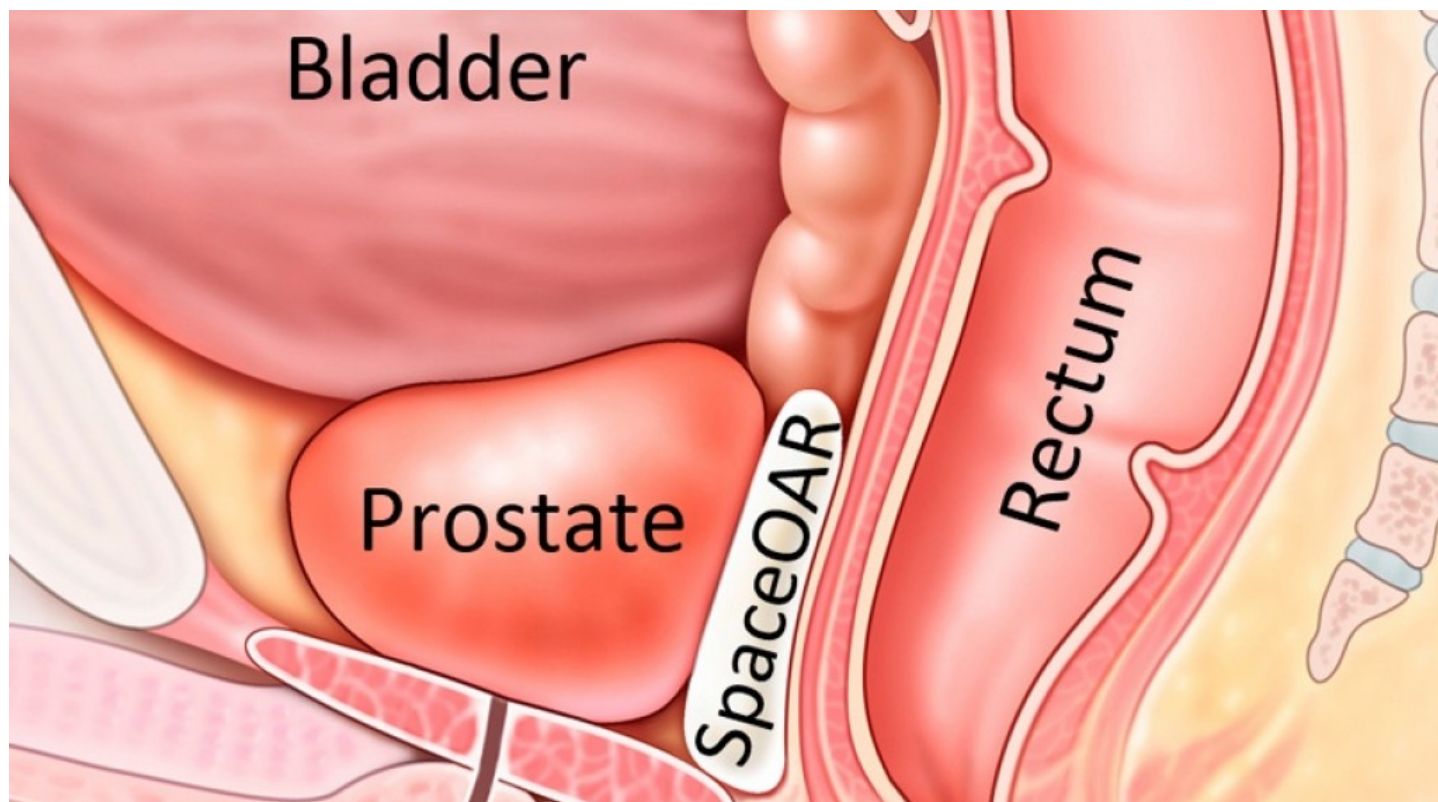


Prostate 911 Donates to Prostate Cancer Foundation
