The neurosurgeons at Michigan Head & Spine Institute use the latest techniques in minimally invasive spine and brain surgery as well as neuroendovascular procedures to treat stroke and aneurysm. Dr. Goldberger regularly treats patients that require: cranial and spinal neurotrauma; cervical, thoracic, and lumbar fusion; kyphoplasty, vertebroplasty and disk arthroplasty; minimally invasive spinal surgery; cerebral angiography; surgical pain management; and worker's compensation and auto injuries.

In his current capacity, he is affiliated with several hospitals and medical centers in his local area, including McLaren Macomb Hospital, Henry Ford Macomb Hospital, Premier Surgical Center of Michigan, FountainView Surgery Center and Novi Surgery Center.

Holding Bachelor of Arts and Master of Science degrees in Neurobiology and Physiology from Northwestern University in Evanston/Chicago, Dr. Goldberger went on to obtain a Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine (DO) degree from the Chicago College of Osteopathic Medicine at Midwestern University in 1995. He went on to a traditional internship and completed his residency in neurological surgery in Metro Detroit through the Michigan State University College of Osteopathic Medicine in Lansing.

He emphasizes a conservative practice philosophy in treating patients. The doctor is board-certified in neurological surgery by the American Osteopathic Board of Surgery, which is the national osteopathic organization that provides board certification to qualified DOs who specialize in the use of surgery to aid in the diagnosis and treatment of disease.

Among his professional affiliations, he is a member of the American College of Osteopathic Surgeons - Neurological Surgery Section, the American Osteopathic Association, and the Michigan Osteopathic Association.

Neurosurgery is the medical specialty concerned with the prevention, diagnosis, surgical treatment, and rehabilitation of disorders which affect any portion of the nervous system including the brain, spinal cord, peripheral nerves, and extra-cranial cerebrovascular system. Neurosurgeons are doctors who diagnose and treat problems with the nervous system, often by performing surgery on the brain or spine. They treat strokes, tumors, cervical and lumbar disc disease, infections, and head or spinal cord injuries.
