Every track of the EP is bursting with the kind of kinetic energy that is usually reserved for live performances.

Eric Van Aro, Alberto Pinelli, Marcello "Bread" Schena, and Antonio "Aki" Chindamo are the pillars of the unique folk band. They sing about all the small things that meander into a collage of memories. The sunk-kissed rhythms and mellow vibes of Blues create a magical atmosphere. They break the boundaries set by the dogmatic society and make the EP about refined love between two gay people in the same industry. With an exceptional theme that celebrates love and kindness more than anything, 'Open Relationship Blues' will touch the deepest core for its jovial and jazzy tunes.

Chronicles of a Fourth is an outstanding band that adds more meaning to country music with the outreaching experimental form. The loud and clear rasps of banjo and guitar tailor to the mesmeric atmosphere whereas the vintage instruments create nostalgic vibes. '**I Hope that I don't fall in Love with You**' is an energetic, light single that gives out a mind-blowing essence of a live gig.
