In addition to their primary role in treating and caring for patients, their responsibilities also include educating patients and the public about a variety of medical conditions, as well as providing emotional support and advice to the families of their patients. Other RN job functions include leadership, research, performing diagnostic tests and analyzing results, operating medical equipment, administering medications, recording patients' symptoms and medical histories, and assisting with patient rehabilitation and follow-up.

A Public Health Nurse (PHN) focuses on the prevention of illness, injury or disability, the promotion of health, and maintenance of the health of populations. By working with whole communities, PHNs are able to educate people about health issues, improve community health and safety, as well as increase access to care.

An Accredited Case Manager (ACM) is responsible for the coordination of the various elements that are involved in the care of an individual patient. Their role is to use resources and services in the best way possible. They assist inside facilities, outside facilities and between different care environments.

A Certified Managed Care Nurse (CMCN) provides oversight of patient care focused on preventive measures to help keep costs down. In managed care, patients have permission to see only specifically designated healthcare professionals.
